Established in 1975, our state-licensed, non-sectarian nursery school believes that a high quality Early Childhood program creates a safe and nurturing school community for young children that fosters life-long learning and emotional well-being. We will maintain open communication between parents and our staff and encourage you to contact the teachers with any questions or concerns you may have. Applications will be accepted for the 2010-2011 school year as follows:

Monday- January 11th: currently enrolled students

Tuesday- January 25th: alumni & members of B'nai Tikvah

Monday- February 1st: for all other prospective students

All children (including half-day kindergarteners) are welcome to enroll in our afternoon enrichment classes whether or not they are enrolled in a morning program.

NEW FOR 2010!!:

**** If you refer a friend who enrolls for the first time in one of our programs, we will take \$100-\$200 off your June, 2011 tuition. Restrictions apply, so please see the Director for details.**

**** "EARLY BIRD" TUITION DISCOUNTS will be given. Please see the "Class Offerings" schedule attached in this packet.**

**** IF YOU PAY FOR THE FULL TUITION (SEPTEMBER 2010 TO JUNE 2011) IN ADVANCE AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION, YOU WILL RECEIVE A 5% DISCOUNT.**

**** If you register your child for a five-day morning program and a full week of enrichments (5 enrichments), you will not be required to pay the fees associated with lunch supervision ((\$4 per day) for a savings of \$80 per month (\$800 per year).**

You may enroll at any time on or after these dates. Please be advised that those whose forms are received first will have first priority in securing their choice of program(s). You must submit any and all required fees required along with your registration for your application to be considered complete. This includes the registration fee and your child's JUNE, 2011 tuition.

Age Requirements for Nursery School enrollment - please note that no exceptions will be made regarding these dates. This is done so that your child is the correct age for your town when entering kindergarten. We appreciate your understanding of this policy.

2 1/2 year old class: Child must be 2 years, six months by September 30th.

3 year old class: Child must be three by September 30th.

Pre-Kindergarten: Child must be eligible for kindergarten in the 2011-2012 school year.

Child must be 4 years old on or before:

September 30th if you are a Princeton resident.

October 1st if you are a North Brunswick resident.

October 31st if you are an East Brunswick resident.

October 31st if you are a Franklin Park resident.

October 31st if you are a Somerset resident.

October 31st if you are a South Brunswick resident.

Pre-K Plus : Children are eligible for this program if they have missed the cutoff for kindergarten in their township or will benefit from an additional year of social and emotional development before kindergarten. Please contact the Director to discuss your child's circumstances and eligibility. All children must have attended a Pre-K program at JCC or another preschool before enrolling in the Pre-K plus program.

Toilet Training Policy: The JCC of North and South Brunswick does not require your child to be toilet trained to join our program. Diapers or wet clothing will be changed when necessary; however, please drop your child off in the morning wearing a clean diaper. The use of pull-ups is permitted. Our school will accommodate your child's needs while in the process of being toilet trained.

Registration Terms and Conditions

I have read and agree to the terms in this application, including but not limited to the following:

1. Payment for June 2011 tuition is due at the time of registration along with the \$75 registration fee. We require the \$75 registration fee and the full payment for the month of June to be considered up to date.

2. Submission of the completed application and fees is not a guarantee of acceptance. Excess applications will be filed in order received and applicants placed on a waiting list. All monies will be refunded if class space is not available.

However, if accepted, the registration fee and June's tuition will not be refunded if the parent withdraws his/her child without Director's prior approval and 30 days written advance notice. If a child is withdrawn within the 30 day period, a refund will be given only if we are able to replace that vacated spot with another child.

3. If a second child is enrolled in the same family, a \$10 sibling monthly discount will apply.

4. Registration for all nursery school programs is considered a commitment for the entire year. Dropping of lunch and/or enrichments will be permitted only with thirty (30) days notice.

5. Tuition is calculated based on a 9.5 month school year for both the morning and enrichment parts of the program. The yearly tuition for all programs is broken down into ten (10) manageable payments for your convenience. The school schedule reflects days off for major Jewish and Secular holidays, school closings, etc. If the tuition for the entire school year is paid at the time of registration, a 5% discount will apply.

6. A \$10 late fee will be imposed for payments received after the 15th of any month.

7. If my child stays for lunch and is not enrolled in the Optional Hot Lunch program, I will provide a **DAIRY** or **VEGETARIAN** lunch only for my child. After lunch, the children will have the opportunity to socialize as well as listen to stories, play games and participate in indoor and outdoor activities (weather permitting). Snacks and juice are served during Enrichment class.

8. Please do not send a child who is sick to nursery school and/or the early stay or late stay programs.

9. No credit will be given for inclement weather. In cases of delayed openings in North Brunswick public schools, Early Stay will begin at 8:30 a.m. In cases of early dismissal in North Brunswick public schools, there will be no Late Stay.

10. No credit will be given for the first three weeks of continuous absence due to illness. Credit will then be given beginning with the fourth week only with a note from your physician. Those students on vacation up to 4 weeks will be charged full tuition (100%). As a courtesy, you will be charged 60% tuition beginning with the 5th week.

Please return the completed application and required fees to the nursery school office. Please make all checks payable to the JCC of North and South Brunswick Nursery School. Returned checks will incur a \$25 fee.
